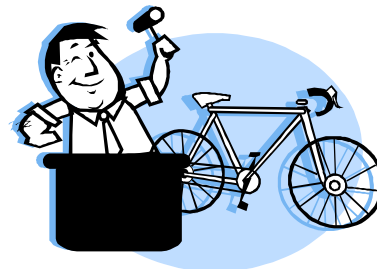

Spring will be here this weekend and we only have five weeks to prepare for launch. I would like all captains to make sure they visit the club and check to see if any dock posts need to be replaced or painted. The posts will be available located next to the garage closest to the showers along with the green paint by April 1, 2011. The green paint will be located in the red paint locker also by the garage. I will be checking all posts within the next week however; each member is responsible for checking, replacing and painting posts in their dock area. No dock painting is permitted after April 28, 2011.
