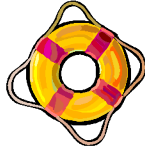


A Message from your Fleet Captain

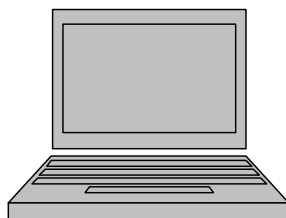
